

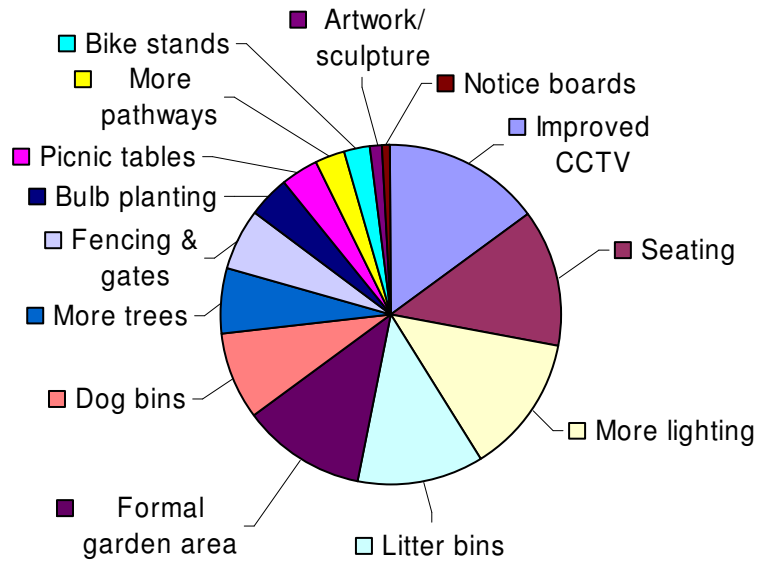

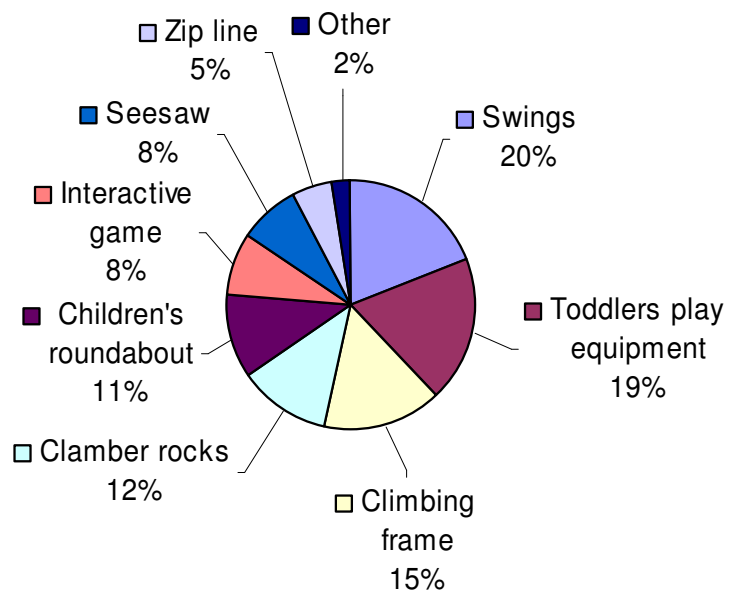
Q1 – Aspects most important in making the area ‘a pleasant, safe, green space for the whole community’.

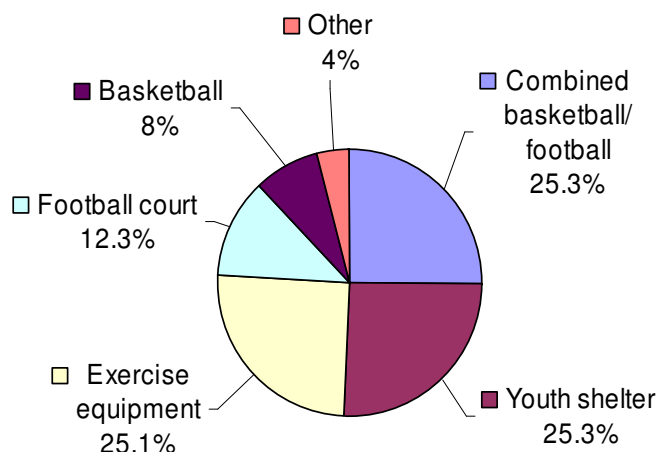


Q3 – Opinion on whether the play areas for toddlers (aged 2-5 years old) and children (aged 6-14 years old) should be separate.
