In addition, fliers/letters/press releases/Outlook article/web page all arranged.</p> <p>Purpose - To prepare up-to-date appraisals and annotated maps for each conservation area and a register of Buildings of Local Interest so that these may then be adopted for Development Control purposes.</p>
What are the dates of the consultation?	Saturday, 3 November until Friday, 14 December 2007 (6 weeks)
Who is being consulted?	Public consultation with emphasis placed on residents affected by the proposals, Knebworth & Codicote Parish Councils, Knebworth Estates and internal consultation with officers.
What areas are being consulted?	District-wide consultation although the geographic area affected relates to Knebworth Parish and part of Codicote Parish (Nup End)
When will the results of the consultation be available?	Deards End Lane and Stockens Green Conservation Area revisions together with the Knebworth Register of Buildings of Local Interest were adopted at Cabinet on 8 th April 2008. Final versions will be made available on NHDC Internet shortly. Old Knebworth Conservation Area Review to be reported back to Southern Rural Committee and Cabinet with earliest adoption date of September 2008
