





- Final agreement in principle: Council, February 2009

Arts, Museums and Heritage Current Proposals for Change: Background



- Proposals aim to improve:
 - Cost effectiveness, and;
 - Visitor experience;
- Long term savings target c £120k in FSR proposals.
- 2009/10 Budget pressures : c £200k loss of interest for 0.5% rate drop.
- Hitchin Town Hall: Limited response for third party management/refurbishment
