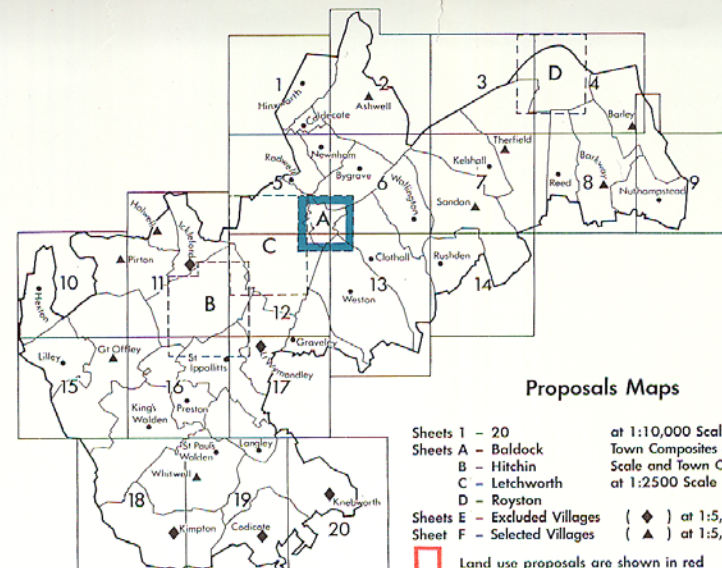

This Key Sheet illustrates the references which link the written statement with the Proposals Maps. Cross-reference from the Proposals Maps to the Written Statement is as follows. BR2. The prefix B indicates Baldock, the R that the primary use in the area is Residential, and the number 3 is the reference to the particular area. If the area is a specific proposal, other numbers are added e.g. BR3/1.

The prefixes used are: B - Baldock, H - Hitchin, L - Letchworth, R - Royston for the towns, and C - Codicote, I - Ickford, K - Kimpton, KS - Knebworth, LW - Little Wymondley for excluded villages. No prefixes are used in the rest of the rural areas, as references relate to the relevant parish.

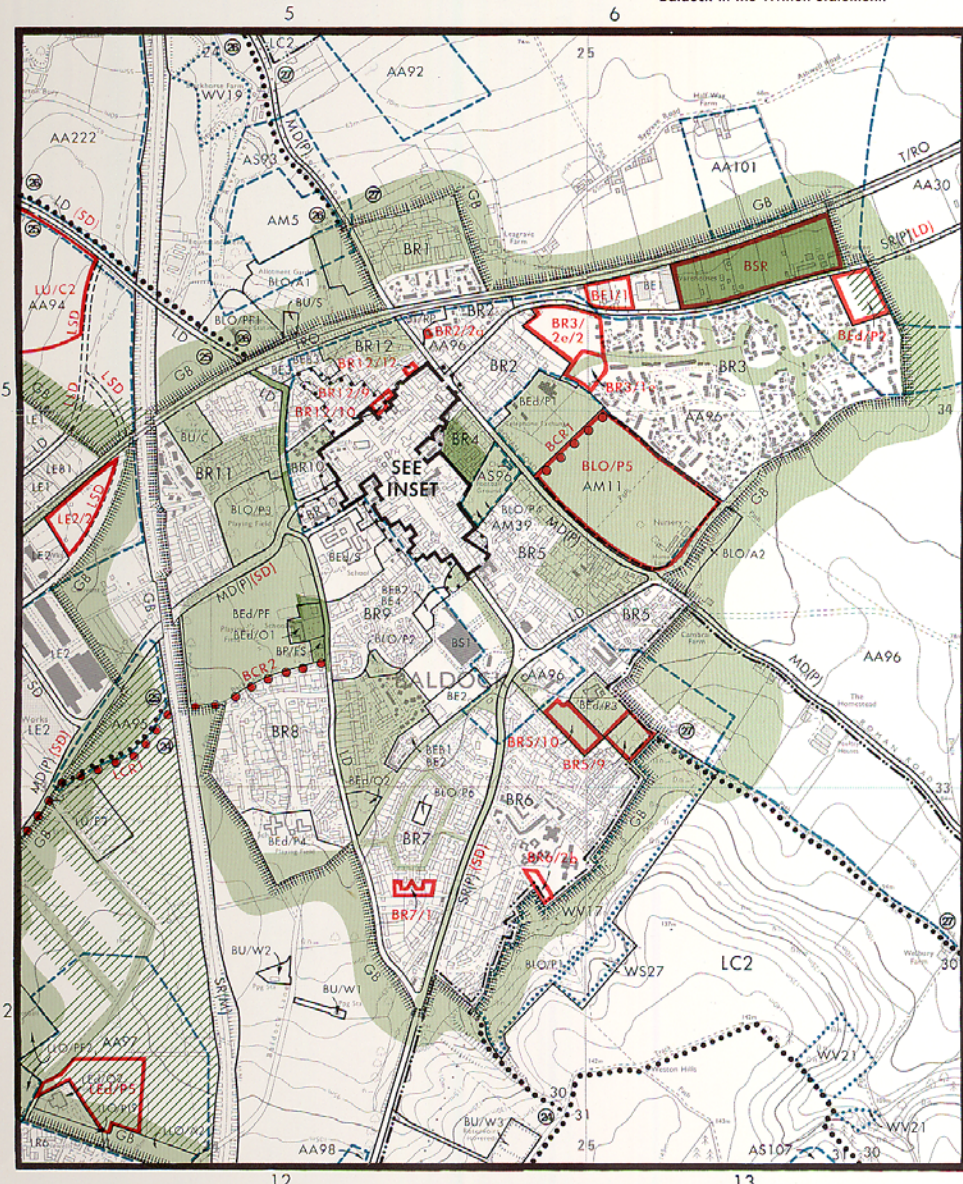
## BALDOCK
