The Project Manager produced a project exception report for the Project Executive on 6<sup>th</sup> November 2013 to outline a delay on the project, the project exception report is attached as appendix 2, and below is an overview of the items that were covered in the report: -

A Pre Meeting with Borras took place on the 20<sup>th</sup> September, at this meeting Borras explained the earliest they could start on site would be 4<sup>th</sup> November.

#### Asbestos

Prior to starting on site the Council arranged for a Refurbishment & Demolition Asbestos Survey to be undertaken to ensure the site is free of asbestos.

The following identifies a list of tasks which need to take place in sequence before the work can start on site.

- 1. 14 and 15 Brand Street needed to be free of tenants, due to the destructive nature of the survey to ensure all asbestos was located prior to demolition.
- 2. The survey needed to be carried out this was done on 15th & 16th October 2013
- 3. Once samples were analysed, the report needed to be issued this was issued on 24<sup>th</sup> October 2013
- Costs for removal of the Asbestos needed to be established and an order placed – this was done by 1<sup>st</sup> November 2013
- 5. There is a statutory 14 day notice period which must be given to the Health and Safety Executive.
- 6. The works are estimated to take a further 14 working days, before a clean air certificate can be issued. Works will start on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2013.

As such the earliest start on site date is established to be 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2013.

The total cost of the survey and removal is £23,500, which is not something that was originally budgeted for. However, is within the overall tolerance of the project.

# **Christmas Closure**

On Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> November 2013 Borras contacted the project team to inform of a further delay on the project of two weeks. The reason for the delay is due to the delay of the start on site date and Christmas closures that take place in the construction industry. On the original project plan a two week closure period had been include for 2013 for the construction phase, however, as the start on site date is now 2nd December 2013, this will mean the construction work will still be taking place in Christmas of 2014, therefore, two weeks of closure will need to be added to the new project plan for the construction phase.

Based on the above information, if Borras start on site on 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2013, the new estimated opening date of the Museum and Town Hall will be 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2015, this equates to an eleven week delay on the project. As Borras will be on site for an additional 2 weeks, there is likely to be additional costs for their welfare facilities, the cost of this is currently unknown.
