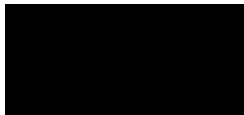
**(FISHPONDS ROAD, BUNYAN ROAD, BANCROFT,
HIGH STREET & MARKET PLACE, HITCHIN)
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE NO. 1) ORDER 2022**

WHEREAS THE North Hertfordshire District Council are satisfied that the passage of vehicles along the full length of Fishponds Road, Bunyan Road from its junction with Fishponds Road to its junction with Bancroft, the full length of Bancroft, the full length of High Street, Market Place from its junction with High Street to its junction with Sun Street, Hitchin should be prohibited to enable the Hitchin Jubilee Carnival to take place.

NOW THEREFORE the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the prevention of obstruction of the streets, within the limits of the special Act, in all times of public processions, rejoicing or illuminations, and in any case when the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed, hereby make the following Order:-

1. Except as provided in Article 2 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Traffic Warden or Police Officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed along the full length of Fishponds Road, Bunyan Road from its junction with Fishponds Road to its junction with Bancroft, the full length of Bancroft, the full length of High Street, Market Place from its junction with High Street to its junction with Sun Street, Hitchin.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful for (a) any Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance vehicles to enter and proceed along that area for emergency purposes or (b) vehicles to obtain access to premises only accessible from that area providing such access does not cause unnecessary danger to any person.
3. This Order shall be operative on Friday 3rd June 2022 between the hours of 10:45 and 15:15 and may be cited as the North Hertfordshire District Council (Fishponds Road, Bunyan Road, Bancroft, High Street, & Market Place, Hitchin) (Temporary Closure No. 1) Order 2022.
