(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2022**

Proposals

The proposal is described in the attached draft Traffic Regulation Order and plan as well as Public Notice of proposals.

North Hertfordshire District Council proposes to add a small number of properties eligible for parking permits into the recently made Controlled Parking Zone Order described as **Zone J**.

Supporting Information

Following representations made to the Zone J Controlled Parking Zone Traffic Regulation Order, the Council has recognised that a small number of properties were omitted from the list of properties eligible for parking permits in Zone J.

The properties to be added are Nos 20 and 21 Old Park Road, 4, 5 and 6 Walsh Close, 52 Pirton Road and Two Ways, Lucas Lane. Representations from residents of these properties confirm that they use the streets included in Zone J to park their own or their visitors cars on a regular basis. The properties 52 Pirton Road and Two Ways, Lucas Lane have their vehicular access off High View and West Hill respectively.

The Council does not wish to prevent residents or their visitors from parking on streets within reasonable walking distance of properties.

The Council considers that adding 7 additional residential properties to the list of those properties eligible for parking permits in Zone J will not be significantly detrimental to the operation of Zone J.

No other changes are proposed to Zone J.
