Update on the Luton Airport Expansion Development Consent Order Examination Note 2

Overview:

Updates on the Luton Airport expansion proposals have been reported regularly to Cabinet through the Strategic Planning Matters Report and through MIS.

This second note follows the MIS note of 4 August which seeks to keep Members informed on the updating members on the Lurton Airport Expansion DCO Examination process.

DCO Application and Pre-examination:

As previously advised Luton Rising formally submitted their application to the Government for a Development Consent Order (DCO) involving the expansion of Luton Airport from 18mppa to 32mppa (including a new terminal and associated infrastructure) on 27 February 2023.

The application was accepted by the Planning Inspectorate (PINS) acting on behalf of the Government on 27 March 2023. That acceptance triggered a range of statutory procedural requirements to enable the application to be considered and determined.

North Hertfordshire, together with the other host authorities (i.e. Hertfordshire County Council (HCC), Luton Borough Council (LBC), Central Beds Council (CBC) and Dacorum Borough Council (DBC) continue to retain specialist consultancy services, to which we have added legal support to assist with our ongoing engagement in the process.

The submission, acceptance and pre-Examination stage of the process has placed a number of requirements on the Council, including submitting:

- an 'Adequacy of consultation' statement— in which the Council advised the Planning Inspectorate on whether in its view the applicant had satisfied the pre-submission consultation requirements set by legislation.

- a 'Relevant Representation' submitted jointly with HCC and DBC setting out our initial views on the application and our overall position.
 - TR020001-001276-LUTN-Rule-8-and-hearings-notification-letter.pdf (planninginspectorate.gov.uk)
- a joint 'Principal Areas of Disagreement Summary Statement' (PADSS) setting out the main areas with which there is disagreement with the applicant.

On 13th July 2023 the Examining Authority published for comment its draft procedural proposals and what it considers to be the 'principal issues' issues generated by the proposal. Officers made written submissions calling for a relaxation of deadlines, suggesting additional principal issues and topics for issue specific hearings.

On 10th August 2023 the Examining Authority held a 'Preliminary Meeting' (PM) at which Interested Parties could express their views on the process and on the principal issues, North Hertfordshire was represented by officers at the PM. The Examination stage formally commenced immediately following the PM and must be completed within 6 months. Following the PM the Examining Authority issued its decision (known as the 'Rule 8' letter, taking into account written submissions, and having heard views at the PM, on the procedure for the remainder of the Examination process). The Rule 8 letter sets out the Examination process in particular Annex A. TR020001-001276-LUTN-Rule-8-and-hearings-notification-letter.pdf (planninginspectorate.gov.uk)

The Examination:

The next immediate substantive requirements for the Council to meet the Examining Authority's requirements where for Deadline 1/1a which included the preparation and submission of a

- Written Representation setting out its views on the proposals by 22nd August.
- Local Impact Report setting out what is considers to be the main impacts within its boundary by 25th August.

The three Hertfordshire hosts authorities, i.e. NHC, HCC and DBC have commissioned specialist technical consultants and a legal team to prepare their Written Representation and Local Impact Report which articulate the position and concerns of the three authorities. The same technical specialists will continue to represent the three host authorities throughout the examination process.

In summary the concerns being articulated through the Hertfordshire host authorities Written Rep include:

- Need case and economic benefits concern that these are over-estimated, relative to conservative projections for Heathrow and Gatwick;
- Community First Fund confirmation as to whether the proposed terms of its operation and scope of eligibility are sufficiently robust and flexible to ensure eligible communities / organisations are fully able to access it;
- Air Quality concerns in relation to ammonia and nitrogen deposition levels at habitat sites;
- Biodiversity further clarity required on compensation for loss of Wigmore Park County Wildlife Site (CWS), and Landscape and Environmental Management Plan (LEMP) monitoring proposal;
- Greenhouse Gases (GHG) Potential underestimate of GHG emissions from aviation (only accounts for one way aviation trips above 3000 feet);
- Cultural Heritage Clarity required about extent of setting and issue of 'quietness';
- Traffic and Transport further modelling information required for public transport and highways (including M1 junction 9-10 works which are not committed, and wider network including to the east and south east of London Luton Airport), and additional detail required for mitigation schemes (including Pirton Road / A505), other interventions to promote and support sustainable travel to/from London Luton Airport, construction traffic, Travel Plan and ongoing monitoring and managing of traffic levels (Transport Related Impacts Monitoring and Mitigation Approach);
- Landscape and Visual clarify approach to Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) from movements, justification for visually prominent structures, and provide night-time assessment;
- Noise and Vibration aviation noise policy is not met due to a lack of noise reduction, with considerable numbers of residents being exposed to increased noise levels. Substantial noise impacts, not in accordance with relevant national and Local Plan policies;
- Water Resources and Flood Risk further information regarding the proposed wastewater infiltration basin are required and liaison on detailed design will be required;
- Economic and Development economic impacts broadly positive, though it
 would be beneficial for these to be articulated at individual local authority
 level.
- Health and Community details required on how impacts on mental health and wellbeing are to be mitigated;
- Unforeseen Local Impact Management Strategy (ULIMS) there is no provision for ULIMS to cover potential future impacts that are not currently identified;
- Surface Access Funding clarification required on whether it is intended to bring forward funding proposals to deliver transport-related projects and schemes. There are no transport related obligations, other than for the specific off-site highways works, proposed in the current application;

 Green Controlled Growth Framework - changes required to improve monitoring and response times, for the Environmental Steering Group (ESG) to direct changes to monitoring and mitigation plans. For noise, to include a range of metrics. For Greenhouse Gases, confirmation that the Limits will not be increased. For Surface Access, to have a better understanding of worse case impacts and appropriate metrics. For Air Quality, better monitoring and reporting regimes.

The submitted LIR only relates to those aspects of the application that potentially have implications for the administrative areas of NHC, HCC and DBC and essentially covers the similar topics as listed in our Written representation.

The next immediate substantive requirements for the Council together with HCC and DBC is Deadline 2 to submit a:

- revised PADSS (Principal Areas of Disagreement) by 12 September, and
- to inform the Examining authority at which Issue Specific Hearings the host authorities wish to have a representation.

The Issue Specific Hearing sessions are set out in Annex A of the Rule 8 letter and will run from Tuesday 26th to Friday 29th September.

LAUNCH OF COMMUNITY INVESTMENT FUND

Following the decision made on 14 August to establish a Community Investment fund utilising £100k from council reserves the fund is being launched on Monday 11 September.

The Community Investment is officially being launched, week commencing Monday 11 September.

Grant values will range from a minimum of £5,000 to a maximum of £20,000.

The Fund is designed to result in a benefit or value for the community/communities of North Hertfordshire. This benefit or 'community value' should be achieved through capacity building.

Capacity Building

Capacity building is about organisations and communities developing and/or strengthening their skills, knowledge, abilities, processes, or resources. Doing so allows organisations and communities to do new activities or improve the things they already do.

Capacity building can help community groups get into a better position to apply for future grants and funding opportunities.

Capacity building should enable the organisation or community group to operate on a long-term basis. It will often help groups to increase their resilience and adapt to changes they are experiencing. Applicants must therefore explain how capacity building will enable them to sustain their projects and services.

Capacity building activities could include:

- Training or mentoring for staff, volunteers, and trustees to fill skills gaps.
- Creating or improving a 'business plan'.
- Doing more work in the community or engaging with a wider audience.
- Purchase of equipment or other resources (e.g., a database, new IT systems)
- Activities to improve staff/volunteer retention or to attract more volunteers.
- Building a network of contacts who you could work with, engage in peer support with, or receive funding from.
- Developing your financial resources exploring new ways of fundraising (e.g., asset transfer, selling your skills, finding new grant opportunities).

- Improving your standards on safeguarding or equalities.

Community Value

Community Value is when the community benefits from positive value. This value could relate to economic support and opportunities, social opportunities, wellbeing, or environmental protection and improvement.

Projects which deliver community value could include:

- Helping people access employment.
- Educational or training activities.
- Activities which encourage civic engagement or community cohesion.
- Activities which alleviate poverty.
- Support for mental or physical health.
- Measures to address climate changes and impacts, reduce impact on the environment, or restore/improve natural environments.

Ultimately, community value is about improving the lives of those within the community and finding solutions to local challenges. All applications to the Fund should have the ultimate aim of delivering community value.

Proposed projects should pertain to at least one of the Council's three Priorities: *People First; Sustainability; A Brighter Future Together*.



- 12.1 In line with the Public Sector Equality Duty, public bodies must, in the exercise of their functions, give due regard to the need to eliminate discrimination, harassment, victimisation, to advance equality of opportunity and foster good relations between those who share a protected characteristic and those who do not.
- 12.2 Central Government and national groups have expressed the continued importance of public Green Space in the health and well-being of communities. From April 2013 local authorities at county level are required to take on the statutory duty to improve the health of their communities as required by the Health and Social Care Act 2012 and with it, to acquire many of the public health services currently the responsibility of the NHS. The use of open spaces, parks, playgrounds and relevant leisure facilities are promoted in terms of reducing the impact of obesity on long term health, the importance in the management of wellbeing and in aiding relaxation, as well as sensory' enjoyment.

Don't miss North Herts' most important Victorian artist

Come to see the district's most prominent painter from the Victorian era, Samuel Lucas, at North Herts Museum in Hitchin from **9 September to 12 November**.

Samuel Lucas (1805 -1870) was born in Hitchin and lived there all his life. He is probably best known for his large oil painting of Hitchin Market Place as it was around 1840, which is on permanent display at the museum. He was born into a Quaker family and was primarily a businessman, farmer and brewer, who painted in his spare time. His work has been displayed at the Royal Academy and is in the collection of the British Museum.

This exhibition concentrates mainly on his watercolours and drawings, including over 40 pieces covering his interest in local landscapes and wildlife, and also his work as a Quaker in the anti-slavery movement.

Cllr Tamsin Thomas, deputy Executive Member for Arts & Enterprise, said: "Samuel Lucas is a very important artist, farmer and anti-slaver for North Herts. This exhibition focuses on his detailed sketch drawings and watercolours with his unique style and technique."

North Herts Museum is located on Brand Street, Hitchin, open Tue-Sat 10.30am-4.30pm and Sun 11am-3pm, this exhibition and general admission is free.
