Thank you for sending through the explanatory note requested by the Inquiry

I have reviewed it and am broadly happy with what is being proposed though I do have a few observations that I hope are constructive

I suggest a restriction to allow only one work area at a time to stop the risk of multiple road closures or diversions.

Priory lane is already busy with new fibre along the left hand side (from Little Wymondley) the important drainage channel to the right and water main down the middle. In addition sewage and gas run from the high street to wymondley hall farm.

The principle of removing spoil and allowing access over steel plates both sound sensible.

At the grid connection end has the route changed to now go up to Redcoats and along towards Sperberry rather straight in from Blakemore End Road.

Do finally be aware that in addition to the Priory Lane impact on businesses the route passes many homes and businesses including two pubs and business units off the high street, Needham House Hotel housing 250 refugees on a long term basis plus in Blakemore End Road and at the junction Redcoats Farmhouse hotel which is busy every day

I trust that all makes sense
