# MEMBERS INFORMATION NOTE

Notice for a Retail and Town Centres Questionnaire to specific stakeholders.

In January 2024, notice was given that residents would be surveyed by telephone on their thoughts and uses of town centres within and outside of the district. Just over a thousand responses have been received, and these are being analysed. Following on from the telephone survey of residents, this notice is to inform members that a survey of specific stakeholders will commence this month.

The specific stakeholders include town centre property owners, property management agencies, charities, colleges, societies, Business Improvement Districts, and trusts.

The questionnaire will be emailed out by the council's retail consultants, Lichfields, in late February. The email will include an officer contact, should stakeholders have any queries.

The questionnaire has been commissioned to gather information from specific stakeholders on the production of new town centre strategies for Baldock, Hitchin, Letchworth Garden City and Royston. The results will become a component of the evidence to inform the council's policy on town centres, both for the new town centre strategies and the review of the Local Plan.

Stakeholder views will be canvased on the health of the main centres, both pre and post Covid, the strengths and weaknesses of the towns and any suggested improvements.

The survey will run from 26 February 2024 – 11 March 2024.

The council and its consultants will review the responses from this survey, along with the responses to the telephone survey. Once the council has reformed after the local election, members will be invited to a workshop which will include a presentation on the findings from these surveys. This is likely to take place in June 2024

The council will not receive any personal data, only collated anonymised data. The collection and use of this data for the purposes of this retail study has undergone and passed a Data Protection Impact Assessment.

The questions included in this survey are as follows:

- How would you best describe the current commercial performance of your town centre?
- How does the current commercial performance of your town centre compare with the pre-Covid period?
- Overall, do you think the current commercial performance of your town centre is: (growing, steady, declining, don't know)?
- What do consider to be your town centre's key strengths and weaknesses as a place to live, work, shop, visit or do business?
- How do you think the town centre's weaknesses can be overcome or what improvements do you think are needed?
- Do you have any other comments in relation to your town centre?

### Bus Service Improvement Plan: Public Consultation on Hitchin Schemes until Sunday 17 March 2024

As part of its Bus Service Improvement Plan (BSIP), Hertfordshire County Council is proposing to give buses greater priority on two roads in Hitchin to shorten journey times and make them more reliable. The aim is to encourage more people to use buses, which make more efficient use of limited road space, and to support the sustainable growth of Hitchin.

The two schemes in Hitchin are:

- A new southbound bus lane along the A600 Bedford Road
- A new northbound bus lane on B656 Queen Street, plus upgrades to bus stops and new pedestrian crossings

#### **Public Consultation**

There is a four-week consultation, ending on **Sunday 17 March**, for the public to review and respond to the proposals. People can find more information online:

### **Paper recycling**

Our communications team have been working on supporting the Shared Waste Service in encouraging residents to separate and recycle their paper. Both districts collect paper separately via a kerbside box (or a paper bin if the residents share waste bins) the paper is then sold as a single material via a Hertfordshire consortium contract. This currently goes to Palm Paper however the contract has been re-tendered so the end destination will change in a few months.

Both councils have noted a decline in paper capture over the last few years, more than can be attributed to the change in peoples paper use (less junk mail, newspapers, or written material). When we compare ourselves with other authority's paper capture (which is also declining) we can see ours has fallen further than predicted.

With this in mind we have all been working behind the scenes to encourage residents to recycle their paper. This has helped us to understand the barriers residents have to recycling their paper. We know that residents may not be aware of how we process paper so our digital comms officer in North Herts has developed the following video.

Other barriers, as you may be aware could include not having a kerbside box, not wanting a kerbside box, or perhaps having experienced losses of kerbside boxes during collections.

We have been working with our contractor to try and reduce instances of lost boxes as this is a cause of frustration for residents and a cost to the council. Urbaser are obligated to report to us if they lose a box during collection. We do get reports from residents regarding box loss that isn't reported so we investigate these instances by using vehicle CCTV. In many instances, this enables us to determine what has happened. We also use CCTV to spot check rounds to ensure the correct methods of collections are being used by staff.

If you do have reports coming to yourselves like this, please encourage residents to order a new box online and you can direct these concerns to us via the CIIr portal for investigation.

We will be sharing other social media assets to further promote paper capture. We have already shared some messages in both districts, so will continue to support residents with these. As always, we appreciate a share or you posting this information on your own channels or within social media groups you may be connected to.

### Money for local drug and alcohol charity giving "hope"

Resolve, an independent substance misuse treatment provider with a base in Letchworth, has been awarded nearly £6,000 by the council's <u>Area Forums</u>.

All five location-based Forums agreed to contribute a total of  $\pounds$ 5,915 to their core running costs –  $\pounds$ 1,500 from each of the Letchworth, Hitchin and Baldock Area Forums,  $\pounds$ 915 from Royston and  $\pounds$ 500 from Southern Rural.
