

Further Guidance following the Covid 19 Pandemic.

Please ensure you also read the litter picking tool kit for practical information about how to hold a safe litter pick.

- Do not litter pick if you, or someone in the group is displaying symptoms of Covid 19 or shielding.
- Following government guidance groups should be no larger than 6
- You will need to collect equipment from our depot in Buntingford at a pre-arranged time. The litter pickers will have been sanitised for you; you will be given Hi-Vis, but these will be for you to keep and re use at future events, as we cannot wash them. Please use disposable gloves. (please spray down litter pickers with a disinfectant spray when you return them to us).
- Wash hands whenever possible.
- Maintain a social distance from other litter pickers as required.
- As per our guidance you should only collect items that can be picked up with a litter picker and place securely in the bags provided. Do not pick up items with your hands, and strictly no large items, these should be left and reported to us.
- Avoid places with lots of people. However, if you are litter picking in small groups ensure you do this safely and refer to the litter picking tool kit.
- Provide hand sanitising or ask volunteers to bring their own.
- Check to ensure that government guidance have not been changed prior to your event if you have planned in advance. We will contact you to advise if your event can go ahead as planned.
- Litter should be bagged and ideally left for 72 hours before it is collected by us, please ensure it is kept in an isolated location. We would like to avoid leaving waste in public places for collection.
