

## Who enforces this law?

Officers of North Hertfordshire District Council and authorised officers will investigate any dog fouling reports.

Anyone responsible for allowing their dog to foul may be served with a written warning. If dog fouling is witnessed by the authorised officer and not cleared by the offender, authorised officers may issue a Fixed Penalty Notice (£50) and will also gather evidence to prosecute offenders.

## Signs and bins

Signs and posters have been erected around the district but it is up to the dog owners to know their dog poo bins or litter bins areas. Litter bins may also be used to dispose of bagged dog mess.

Look out for our official signs and posters with the NHDC logo.



## How you can help

If you know of any dog owners who do not clean up after their dogs you should report them to North Hertfordshire District Council.
